International Guest meets Nursing Leaders at Bethesda Hospital

The WAHSN has been formed as a partnership between nursing programs from The University of Western Australia, Edith Cowan University, The University of Notre Dame Australia and Curtin University, and supported by the Nursing and Midwifery Office of the WA Department of Health.

Chief Executive Officer of Bethesda Hospital, Ms Yasmin Naglazas said 'that meeting with Dr McGlowan is a tremendous opportunity for Bethesda's nursing leaders to showcase and discuss their nursing achievements and practices.
